

INFORMATION REGARDING LANGUAGE TESTS FOR MEDICINE APPLICANTS 2024-25



1- PROCEDURE

To be admitted to either stream of the Bachelor's Degree in Medicine, applicants must be able to demonstrate a minimum of a B1 level of ability (according to the CEFR1) in the language the degree is taught in. There are two ways that students can demonstrate this:

Submission of a certificate: those applicants who possess any of the language certificates listed in the table below can submit their certificate via the admissions platform.

CERTIFICATE TABLE

Participation in a level test: those applicants who do not possess any of the certificates listed must sit a level test. Applicants can register for this test via a link in section 3.

2- FORMAT OF THE LEVEL TEST

There will be two parts to the level test.

<u>Grammar and vocabulary:</u> applicants will undertake a multiple-choice test, lasting 45 minutes. The test document will only be available at the time and date selected.

<u>Oral interview:</u> applicants must reply to a series of general questions and complete tasks as required by the examiner. Students will be assigned a slot for the oral interview during the same week as for the grammar and vocabulary test. Applicants will be sent an appointment for the oral interview to take place via Teams. The oral interview can only take place via this platform. No other platforms will be used.

The video-conferencing option on Teams will be used for this purpose. Applicants must ensure that they possess the appropriate equipment to participate in the oral interview (i.e. which enable live online communication using a camera and a microphone). Before beginning, applicants will be asked to identify themselves by showing their national identity card or passport.

3-REGISTRATION FOR THE LEVEL TEST

Those applicants who wish to undertake the level test must register via the link below, selecting one date only for the grammar and vocabulary test. The staff at the Languages Service will then assign a slot for an oral interview to each applicant.

When registering, applicants must use their University email address.
